Wc/ 4 th Nov	<p>EAD- Firework Pictures- Talk to the children about bonfire night and the different things that we do to celebrate this occasion. Encourage them to make their own firework pictures using glitter and card.</p> <p>Resources: Card, glue. Scissors, glitter, paint, craft materials.</p> <p>Learning Objectives: EAD- Creating with Materials- Continues to explore colour and how colours can be changed (R5)</p>	<p>UW- Making a bonfire- Using wood and a fire pit, create a bonfire to celebrate bonfire night. Talk about the different safety precautions that need to be taken as well as how a fire is created. Use sticks to cook marshmallows and other nibbles for the children to eat.</p> <p>Resources: Fire pit, wood, lighter, paper, marshmallows, sticks, sparklers</p> <p>Learning Objectives: CL- Understanding- Beginning to understand why and how questions (R5)</p>	<p>LD- Phonics Rhyming Game - Use the rhyming sacks and other rhyme games to assess children's understanding of rhythm and rhyme. Ask the children to go around the room to see if they can find the objects around the room that they think rhyme.</p> <p>Resources: Rhyming sacks and games.</p> <p>Learning Objectives: LD- Shows awareness of rhyme and alliteration (R5)</p>
Wc/ 11 th Nov	<p>PD- Obstacle Course- Using the outdoor building blocks and planks create an obstacle course for the children. Assess their sense of balance and co-ordination as well as their physical capabilities of tackling problems.</p> <p>Resources: Outdoor building blocks, planks and tires.</p> <p>Learning Objectives: PD- Moving & Handling- Climbs stairs, steps and moves across climbing equipment using alternate feet. Maintains balance using hands and body to stabilise, (R5)</p>	<p>UW- Pooh sticks- Set up a water fall using the outdoor equipment. Using autumnal materials like conkers, pine cones and leaves, encourage the children to race different items to see which travels faster and which travels slower down the waterfall. See if they can explain to you why.</p> <p>Resources: Leaves, conkers, guttering, hose, pine cones.</p> <p>Learning Objectives: UW- The World- Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world (R5)</p>	<p>MD- Counting & Sorting - ask the children to count out a range of natural objects, such as conkers or pine cones. Sort them into groups and match them with the correct numeral.</p> <p>Resources: Number cards, pine cones, conkers</p> <p>Learning Objectives: MD-Comparison- Compares two small groups of up to five objects, saying when there are the same number of objects in each group, e.g. You've got two, I've got two. Same! (R5)</p> <p>MD- Counting- May enjoy counting verbally as far as they can go. (R5)</p>

<p>Wc/ 18th Nov</p>	<p>EAD- Painting the Nativity figures- We will be making a Christmas wall display of the nativity scene. Encourage children to paint and draw the characters they are playing so that they can be displayed.</p> <p>Resources: Paint Paper Pictures and photos to support</p> <p>Learning Objectives: EAD- Being Imaginative & Expressive- Creates representations of both imaginary and real-life ideas, events, people and objects (R6)</p>	<p>PSED- Christmas Nativity Practice This week we will start to practice our Christmas nativity play with the children. Children will be allocated roles to play and we will be putting on a special performance at the end of the term.</p> <p>Resources: Costumes Script</p> <p>Learning Objectives: PSED: Understanding Emotion- Understands that expectations vary depending on different events, social situations, and changes in routine, and becomes more able to adapt their behaviour in favourable conditions. (R5)</p>	<p>CL- Story of the Christmas Nativity - Read the story of the Christmas nativity to the children in the group. Use models and other resources to act it out and illustrate to them. Refer to the fact that they will be acting out the story for our Christmas play.</p> <p>Resources: Nativity story Puppets/ visual aids to support</p> <p>Learning Objectives: CL: Listening & Attention- Listens to familiar stories with increasing attention and recall (R5)</p>
<p>Wc/ 25th Nov</p>	<p>EAD- Making Christmas Cards- Provide the children with photographs and images to help inspire them to make their own Christmas card. Provide them with a craft activity book to pick and choose the cards that they want to make if they wish.</p> <p>Resources: Craft materials and resources Christmas photographs and cards</p> <p>Learning Objectives: EAD- Creating with Materials: Creates representations of both imaginary and real-life ideas, events, people and objects (R6)</p>	<p>EAD- Making Christmas tree decorations- This week the children will be creating and making Christmas decorations. This may consist of biscuits or other craft decorations.</p> <p>Resources: Biscuit ingredients Craft resources for making tree decorations</p> <p>Learning Objectives: EAD- Creating with Materials- Uses their increasing knowledge and understanding of tools and materials to explore their interests and enquiries and develop their thinking. (R6)</p>	<p>UW- Making Calendars- Make calendars with the children in the group. Talk about the different seasons of the year and the events that occur in different months, such as birthdays and Christmas.</p> <p>Resources: Craft resources Paint Glue Calendar tags</p> <p>Learning Objectives: UW- The World- Looks closely at similarities, differences, patterns and change in nature (R6)</p>

<p>Wc/ 2nd Dec</p>	<p><u>Dance Bag, Christmas theme</u> Ask the children to pretend being snowflakes falling from the sky. Talk about how snowflakes look and how they should move when imitating them. Encourage them to move according to the story being told.</p> <p>Resources: Dance Bag Materials</p> <p>Learning Objectives: EAD: Being Imaginative & Expressive- Chooses particular movements, instruments/sounds, colours and materials for their own imaginative purposes (R6)</p>	<p><u>MD- Making Christmas Cookies-</u> Make Christmas cookies for the children to take home and leave for father Christmas when he arrives on Christmas eve.</p> <p>Resources: Chocolate chips Flour Sugar Eggs Grease proof paper</p> <p>Learning Objectives: MD- Measures- Becomes familiar with measuring tools in everyday experiences and play (R6)</p>	<p><u>UW-Decorating Christmas Tree</u> This week we will be decorating our Christmas tree in the nursery garden and inside the main room. Children will be encouraged to make decorations and we will be talking about Christmas traditions.</p> <p>Resources: Ladder Christmas tree Decorations</p> <p>Learning Objectives: UW- People and Communities- Remembers and talks about significant events in their own experience (R5)</p>
<p>Wc/ 9th Dec</p>	<p><u>MD- Making Christmas Cakes -</u> Make some Christmas pudding cakes with the children in the group. Mix the ingredients and decorate them with holly and icing.</p> <p>Resources: Ingredients for cake Icing Cellophane Ribbon</p> <p>Learning Objectives: MD- Measures- Enjoys tackling problems involving prediction and discussion of comparisons of length, weight or capacity, paying attention to fairness and accuracy. (R6)</p>	<p><u>UW- Christmas Outing TBC -</u> Every year the children at nursery go on a special Christmas day out. This year the visit has not yet been confirmed.</p> <p>Resources: TBC</p> <p>Learning Objectives: UW- The World- Comments and asks questions about aspects of their familiar world such as the place where they live or the natural world. (R5)</p>	<p><u>LD- Writing Letters to Father Christmas-</u> Set up a writing area or grotto where children can enter and write their letters to Father Christmas identifying the different things that they would like for Christmas.</p> <p>Resources: Envelopes Letters Paper Pencils Stamps</p> <p>Learning Objectives: LD- Writing: Enjoys creating texts to communicate meaning for an increasingly wide range of purposes, such as making greetings cards, tickets, lists, invitations and creating their own stories and books with images and sometimes with words, in print and digital formats (R6)</p>

<p>Wc/ 16th Dec</p>	<p><u>CL- Movie Afternoon:</u> One afternoon this week set up the big screen and bring in some festive DVD's and have a movie day. Allow children to prepare for the day by making popcorn and selling tickets.</p> <p>Resources: Large screen DVD's Popcorn Tickets</p> <p>Learning Objectives: CL- Listening & Attention - Focusing attention - can still listen or do, but can change their own focus of attention (R5)</p>	<p><u>PSED- Christmas Show</u> This week the children will be performing their Christmas show!
